The title of the field report was STUDY ON THE TOURISM INDUSTRY AND ITS IMPACT ON ENVIRONMENT (A CASE STUDY ON RISHAPH OF DARJEELING DISTRICT OF WEST BENGAL). 100 percent of the students took part in the said excursion. The tour was conducted through a renowned Taki, Hasanabad based tour operator, “TAKI TOUR AND TRAVEL”.
